Participant Consent Agreement

Traversing tidal waters by small human powered craft has significant risks. The Community Paddle for the Coast is a voluntary advocacy initiative, not a guided expedition, and all participants are personally responsible for their own safety as well as the safety of the group. If you are unsure of your ability to confidently participate in this journey please access training from a professional instructor for the type of craft you intend to use.

Participants should be aware of the risk of capsize, marine-based collision and other accidents, throughout the journey and particularly in the vicinity of Inner Harbour.

Participants should also be aware of health risks, including those arising from their own medical condition as well as their personal conduct on the journey. Risks relating to weather and other site conditions include hypothermia, dehydration, heat stroke, injury and death.

- I have read this Consent Agreement and I accept personal responsibility for the risks entailed in participating in the Community Paddle for the Coast, and I agree not to make any claim against people associated with organizing the Community Paddle for the Coast for any injury or loss to person or property arising from their actions or inactions.

- I have read the Community Paddle for the Coast Safety Policy and I agree to comply with its provisions, recognizing that failure to do so will result in my immediate expulsion from the group.

- I hereby grant permission to organizers of the Community Paddle for the Coast and their agents to use photographs and/or video of me taken on December 14, 2019 at Victoria Harbour in advocacy and communications materials.
